Using photos, mixed media and a sense of humor, create a self-portrait, family or friend's portrait, or one of your family pet. We combine photos, paint, collage, writing, fabric and found objects for a special piece filled with personality.

#### **Vera, JUNE: Adult Clay Play I**

Basics for working with polymer clays. Conditioning, Skinner blend and other mixing techniques, cane making. Work on a flat polymer project such as buttons, jewelry or tiles. Some materials provided.

#### **Vera, JULY: Adult Clay Play II**

Learn more advanced cane making, millifiori and moku gane. We will make a “palette’ of these patterns to use on flat and 3-D projects. Bring your own supplies.

#### **Vera, JULY: Adult Clay Play III**

Build a 3-D polymer clay figure embellished with your canes and Skinner blends, or continue with metallics and translucent moku gane on beads and other objects. *Bring your own supplies.*

#### **Michael, MAY: Drawing Without Pencils**

Using charcoal, learn to create mass, volume and values in still life, and landscape. You will be amazed at the impact a charcoal drawing with good values can have. We'll work from still life, photos and, weather permitting, outside. *Bring vine charcoal, a kneaded eraser, and 14x17 pad of 80# Srathmore drawing paper.*

#### **Michael, MAY: Abstracts - What Fun!**

Learn to think outside the box. And paint outside the lines. Students may use acrylics or medium of choice. We'll use exercises, photographs, set ups to encourage our sense of adventure to explore the realm beyond reality. **Thurs., 5/7, 5/14, 5/21, 5/28 6-8:30 pm. \$65**

#### **Michael, JUNE & JULY: Monoprint Workshop**

Monoprinting combines the challenge of printmaking process with the fun of painting for entry level and experienced artists alike. Printing plates, artist grade printmaking paper, brayers and rolling pins will be provided. Students should bring oil paint, brushes, paint thinner, painting knives, and any sort of material that would leave a pattern or texture, such as dried leaves or other plant material, lace, stencils. **2 Sessions Offered: Mon., June 8 5-9 pm. \$45**

#### **Michael, JULY: More Drawing Without Pencils**

Build on an understanding of values and massed tone, then add color with dry pastel if you really want to see things “pop” into reality. Work from still life, photos and, weather permitting, outside. *Bring a multi colored pad of pastel paper, kneaded eraser and a set of 15 colors of soft pastel.* **Mon., 7/6, 7/13, 7/20, 7/27 6-8:30 pm. \$65**

#### **Jane, JUNE: Words Into Painting**

We will experiment with interesting ways to incorporate words, phrases, quotations and bits of poetry into the surface of your painting. Some words may be bold, some soft and some hidden. This is an exciting way to personalize your art work. Mixed media techniques

and water media enhance the process.
